



Outline of the Building Regulations

This two-day course has been designed to raise awareness and understanding of the building regulations specifically for application in the Kitchen and Bathroom Industry.

In particular it covers their relevance in the Electrical, Plumbing, Ventilation, and Heating Sectors, all of which feature in the supply and fitting of Kitchens and Bathrooms.

How the Building Regulations are integral to design, which must take account of the requirements of them from the initial stages right through to final 'as fitted' design.

It specifically covers aspects raised within parts P (Electrical), L1a, L1b, L2a, L2b (Fuel and Energy Conservation), F (Ventilation), J (Combustion Appliances and Fuel Storage), H (above ground Drainage and Waste Disposal), G (Hygiene) and M (Access for all).

It also includes direction in how, after the expansion of Section 2A of the building regulations, contractors and installers are able to self certify by joining scheme operators such as NAPIT.

The course is a mixture of classroom and practical and it incorporates site visits to sample property where deviations from the building regulations may be found.

A comprehensive set of documents is provided to take away, which include course notes, fact sheets and frequently asked questions (with answers).
